Description: California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) has amended <u>Title 27, California Code of Regulations 25607.2(b)</u>, to provide an additional safe harbor warning option for businesses that cause significant exposures to acrylamide from food products.

The Office of Administrative Law (OAL) approved the rulemaking on 4 October 2024. The effective date for the regulation is 1 January 2025.
