The following communication, dated 18 October 2024, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of the United States of America.

Title: Notice of Proposed Rulemaking Title 27, California Code of Regulations Safe Harbor Warnings for Acrylamide Exposure from Food

Description: California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) has amended Title 27, California Code of Regulations 25607.2(b), to provide an additional safe harbor warning option for businesses that cause significant exposures to acrylamide from food products.

The Office of Administrative Law (OAL) approved the rulemaking on 4 October 2024. The effective date for the regulation is 1 January 2025.
