Description of content: This regulation has stipulated that the Marine and Fisheries Quality Assurance Agency/MFQAA (as the Competent Authority responsible for the quality and safety of fish and fisheries products in Indonesia as previously notified WTO G/SPS/N/IDN/147 dated 5 December 2023) has the authority to conduct inspection and certification as well as official control of quality and safety of fish and fishery products from upstream to downstream level in following the certification scheme of the fishery sector in Indonesia as the baseline to issue Certificate of Quality and Safety Assurance for Fish and Fishery Product by MFQAA. The Certificate consists of: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Good Handling Practices (including onboard fishing vessels)2. Good Hatchery Practices3. Good Aquaculture Practices4.
