- **6. Description of content:** These Guidelines describes the following:
  - 1. lists of regulated electrical equipment;
  - 2. procedures and conditions that shall be complied with by the applicants in the submission of the application for the following:
  - 3. the Certificate of Registration (CoR) to manufacture or import;
  - 4. the CoR as a Conformity Assessment Body (CAB);
  - 5. the Certificate of Approval (CoA) to import, manufacture, display, sell or advertise any electrical equipment; and
  - 6. the renewal of the CoA to import, manufacture, display, sell or advertise any electrical equipment;
  - 7. national deviation;

- 8. energy efficiency; and
- 9. labelling requirements.

These Guidelines shall be applicable to all manufacturers, importers, exhibitors, sellers and advertisers of any regulated electrical equipment and registered laboratories and certification body in ensuring compliance to the Electricity Supply Act 1990 [Act 447] and the Electricity Regulations 1994 [P.U.(A) 38/1994].

- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: The objectives of the Guidelines are as follows:
  - 1. To facilitate manufacturers and importers on the information and procedures to manufacture or import electrical equipment into Malaysia.
  - 2. To inform the manufacturers, importers, exhibitors, sellers and advertisers of any regulated electrical equipment of the revised International Electrotechnical Commission ("IEC") standards and the Malaysian Standards ("MS Standard") that is accepted in Malaysia for the purpose of the CoA approval.
  - 3. To cater to the development of technologies on electrical equipment.
  - 4. To act as a prevention of deceptive practices for the purpose of protection to the consumer, human health and safety and the environment.
