This addendum concerns the notification of the Ministerial Decree No. 245 /2025 (4 pages, in Arabic) that gives the producers and importers a six -month transitional period to abide by the Egyptian Standard ES 9100 "cullet glass used for recycle - general characteristics and requirements"; (15 page(s), in Arabic).

It should be noted that the draft of this standard was formerly notified in [G/TBT/N/EGY/545](#) dated 12 May 2025.

worth mentioning is that this standard complies with the following:

- Commission Regulation (EU) No 1179/2012 establishing criteria determining when glass cullet ceases to be waste under Directive 2008/98/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council.
